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# A Year of Highlights: The Door Youth Centre 2024

The Door Youth Centre had an extraordinary 2024, marked by numerous highlights that underscored its commitment to engaging youth, fostering creativity, and building a strong sense of community. Throughout the year, the centre delivered a rich array of programs and events tailored to meet the diverse needs of its members, ensuring a safe and inclusive environment for all.

### **Engaging Programs and Activities**

Each month brought opportunities for youth to participate in life skills workshops, art sessions, cultural celebrations, Girls' Nights, sports, and educational initiatives like Career Days and mental health workshops. These activities were designed not only to entertain but also to empower youth by providing valuable skills and experiences. The Black Youth Leadership initiative, sponsored by the Michelle Jean Foundation, and the Young Chefs program, funded by the City of Ottawa, were among the standout programs. These initiatives equipped participants with practical skills and encouraged personal growth and empowerment, leaving a lasting impact on their lives.

### Emphasis on Inclusivity and Diversity

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Inclusivity remained at the heart of The Door's mission. The centre celebrated diversity through cultural events and meaningful discussions on essential topics, such as mental health and leadership. Youth found a welcoming and supportive space to express themselves and learn from one another, fostering a deeper sense of belonging.

### **Community Engagement and Celebrations**

Community engagement was a cornerstone of the year, highlighted by successful events like the 30th-anniversary celebration, The 13th Annual International Dinner, and collaborations with local organizations. These events strengthened bonds among members and showcased the centre's vital role as a hub for both youth and the broader community.

Field trips sponsored by the Ottawa Community Foundation added to the memorable experiences, with visits to Saunders Farm and Flying Squirrel offering excitement and opportunities for connection. Themed celebrations, including Black History Month events and the festive Christmas dinner, brought joy and unity to all who attended.

### By the Numbers: A Snapshot of 2024

- Youth Participation: A total of 276 youth attended The Door in 2024, logging 5,233 visits—an average of 22 visits per night. Among them, 182 were new members, and 100% of surveyed participants reported making new friends.
- Volunteer Contributions: The centre benefitted from the dedication of 123 volunteers (82 adults and 41 youth), who collectively contributed 5,381 hours of service.
- Programs and Workshops: Youth spent 388 hours in the homework room and participated in 125 hours of music lessons. Workshops offering life skills saw an impressive 96% satisfaction rate among surveyed participants. Cooking lessons accounted for 28 hours, while 25 youth took part in community and fundraising events.
- Support Provided: An incredible 9,730 meals and snacks were served throughout the year, underscoring The Door's commitment to meeting the basic needs of its members.
- Fundraising: The centre and its supporters organized 28 successful fundraising events and campaigns, ensuring the sustainability of its programs.

### Looking Ahead

As The Door Youth Centre reflects on the successes of 2024, it remains steadfast in its mission to support and empower youth. With a strong foundation built on inclusivity, community, and personal growth, the centre looks forward to continuing its impactful work in the years to come.

Are you looking for a way to help your youth thrive in school and build confidence in their



- Wednesdays provide well-rounded support in French, English, History, Art, Math, and Sciences.
- Thursdays emphasize Computer Programming alongside help in French, Art, History, and English.
- Fridays bring the week to a close with comprehensive support in English, Sciences, Art, History, Spanish, French, and Math.

Spaces fill quickly, so sessions are on a first-come, first-served basis, with the option to sign up ahead of time for guaranteed assistance.
